










Existing Greenways – green

Last mile connections (black dotted line) to be delivered in conjunction with Local Authorities.


Total trail realisation – approximately 350km of trail

- Project spans to the east and west of the Royal Canal Greenway
















Westmeath

- Construction ongoing






















Offaly West

- 4.5 km link from gateway carpark to Clonmacnoise in development phase.












Tipperary

- Will link in with existing trail developed on BnM land












Roscommon

- Construction planning underway












Offaly East

- Awaiting decision













Gateways & Rest points

- Regeneration of old railway lines for infrastructure.








Gateway – walker totem

- Proposal for 28 Walker totems along the trails as trail identifiers.
- Constructed from 9.1m sections of narrow gauge light railway line
- A nod to Bord na Mona industrial heritage
- Concept developed by Feeney McMahon landscape architects
- Fabrication by Bord na Mona craft employees.
