








A heritage composed of city centers, architectural monuments, industrial cities, archaeological sites but also natural wonders, unique places and landscapes







- **Tourism Strategy 2017-2022** Mibact. Soft Mobility targets, hiking trails, tourist railways, cycle paths
- August 2, 2017: Law on tourist railways is approved
- Approval of Law 2/2018 on the enhancement of cycling mobility and creation of a cycling pathways network. The network is set to be closely combined to other soft mobility infrastructures walking pathways and hiking trails, tourist railways, bridleways, river ways and greenways. More funding to tourist cycling paths.

These networks are closely linked to the Italian cultural and historic heritage.









Italian pathways are taking steps ahead

- Associations and volunteer work for the development of the pathways
- Via Francigena pathway becomes reality
- 2016: Mibact promotes « The year of walks» in Italy
- More resources to Via Francigena and Appia Regina Viarum pathways
- Mibact Walks Atlas, comprising 42 routes
- Regional commitment to the pathways
- Promotion of travelling, local guides, festivals







Cycling mobility keeps on growing

- Associations and volunteer work
- 2016: the network of national tourist cycle paths promoted by Transportation and Infrastructure Ministry is born
- 500 million funding from the Ministry in the budget balance reforms 2016 to 2018, alongside local and regional co-financing
- 10 tourist cycle paths are in the planning phase: VenTo, Ciclovia del Sole, G.R.A.B, Ciclovia Acquedotto Pugliese, Ciclovia del Garda, Ciclovie Sarda, Ciclovia Magna Grecia, Ciclovia Tirrenica, Ciclovia Adriatica and Ciclovia Trieste Venezia










- Volunteer and association involvement, for over 20 years: Treno Blu and Treno Natura
- 2013. FS Foundation with the "Timeless tracks" project on 9 tourist lines
- Many tourist services on ordinary and regional lines (Astra affiliated): Trenino Verde sardo, Treno della Sila Calabria
- August 2, 2017: Law on tourist railways is approved
- 18 highly valuable railways, and more to come
- Cicloferro project: cycling on the railway









- Rete Ferroviaria Italiana and FS have presented a «Travel atlas along disues railways»
- To date, 800 km of disused network have been restored
- Toll booths and stations valuable for tourist accommodation





The Via Verde greenway on the Trabocchi coast




