







# EAKNESESS

## Action 1: <u>Development and Promotion of Greenways including</u> <u>Culture and Heritage Assets – Funded through Regional</u> <u>Operational Programme 2021 -2027.</u>

The aim of this action is to influence the development of the Regional Operational programme 2021 -2027 by having specific allocation of funding from the ROP 2021-2027 allocated to the development of Greenways. In addition to this, a portion of the fund should be allocated the preservation and promotion of Cultural and heritage assets along Greenways and to facilitate the development of Start-up businesses along greenways.



### Action Establish a Regional Forum to Develop Greenways

The aim of this action is to establish a regional Forum that would support the development of Greenways through increased collaboration and knowledge sharing between key regional stakeholders.

The Regional Greenway Forum would serve as a platform for key stakeholders including Local Authorities Fáilte Ireland, Waterways Ireland and the Department of Transport of Tourism to develop plans for larger greenways that extend beyond County boundaries.

The Forum would also allow local authorities to share and discuss common challenges and potential solutions and identify opportunities for funding.

#### <u>Aim</u>

The aim of this action is to establish a regional Forum that would support the development of Greenways through increased collaboration and knowledge sharing between key regional stakeholders.


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From 2018 – 2020 the Northern and Western Regional Assembly has been developing the Regional Spatial and Economic Strategy (RSES) for the region. This strategy aims to provide regional level strategic planning and economic policy in support of the implementation of the National Planning Framework and provide a greater level of focus around the National Policy Objectives and National Strategic Outcomes of the NPF. Included in the Strategy is a section on the value and strategy to develop significant greenways of scale across the region. The adoption and publication of the Regional Strategy means that each Local Authority (County *Council) will now review and update each County & City Development Plan*

Expansion of Greenways firmly embedded now in National / Regional / Local Policy
